Certification Dives

There are several ways to perform Open Water Certification Dives. You may do a referral (Atlantis Divers does the Academic and Pool Instruction and you get certified on a trip by another facility), or you can dive with us at a local dive site or take a trip with Atlantis Divers to get certified.

Open Water Certification Dives are held the last weekend of each month at Lake Rawlings. Other local and exotic dive sites are optional.

After completion of your course, you can opt for a referral and do your check out dives anywhere in the world or continue on to your check out dives with Atlantis Divers. In this course you will:

Home Study -included

- Read the text book
- Complete the knowledge reviews

- Summarize and review textbook

Confined Water Dives (Pool)-included

- Apply new knowledge in a controlled environment

Certification Dives (Open Water)

- In-water evaluation of skills (*at an additional cost of \$150 + personal gear*)

SUPPLIES

Required Course Supplies:

Crew-Pak/Textbook with Log Book, and Video or DVD (included)

Required Personal Dive Gear:

Bathing Suit and Towel Only!

Fins, mask, snorkel and weight belts are supplied for all pool dives by Atlantis Divers
