SUPPLIES

Required Course Supplies:

Crew-Pak/Textbook, Video or DVD (NAUI), Log Book and pocket mask.

Required Dive Gear:

Personal Dive Gear (Fins, Booties, Mask, Snorkel, Weight belt), Weights, Regulator, BCD, Wetsuit, Primary Dive Light, Backup Dive Light, Glow Stick, Slate, Cutting Tool

PRICES

Class Fee \$325

*Class Fee does not include Student Crew-Pak/Textbook, pocket mask or rental gear.
Class Fee includes quarry admission, tanks, rescue and first aid equipment.*

CANCELLATION POLICY

Advanced Open Water Diver Certification Required
Medic/First Aid/CPR training within past 24 months (All offered at Atlantis Divers)
Each student needs to be in good health, reasonably fit, and comfortable in the water
Students must be older than the age of 15
Maintain a good attitude
Complete all knowledge reviews
Adherence to Instructor guidance
Be on time for class
